APPELLEES' JOINT MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE AND SERVE THEIR NEW BRIEFS

TO THE HONORABLE SUPREME COURT OF NORTH CAROLINA:

Plaintiffs-Appellees Hoke County Board of Education *et al.*, Plaintiff-Intervenors Rafael Penn *et al.*, and Plaintiff-Intervenor-Appellee Charlotte-Mecklenburg Board of Education (collectively, the "Plaintiff-Appellees"), and Defendant-Appellee State Board of Education (the "State Board Appellee") hereby jointly move, pursuant to Rule 27(c) of the North Carolina Rules of Appellate Procedure, for a thirty (30) day extension of time, to and including 24 July 2013, in which to file and serve their new briefs in this matter. In support of this joint motion, the Plaintiff-Appellees and the State Board Appellee state as follows:

- 1. Appellant State of North Carolina served its brief in this matter, by U.S. Mail, on 20 May 2013.
- 2. Each of the Plaintiff-Appellees and the State Board Appellee anticipate filing a responsive brief. The deadline for the Plaintiff-Appellees and the State Board Appellee to file their briefs with this Court is currently 24 June 2013.

- 4. The Plaintiff-Appellees and the State Board Appellee have not previously been granted any extensions of time for filing or serving their briefs.
 - 5. The Plaintiff-Appellees and the State Board Appellee need additional

- 6. Appellant State of North Carolina was granted an initial 30-day extension of time by Order dated 25 March 2013 and an additional 12-day extension of additional time by Order dated 30 April 2013 to file its appellant brief in this matter.
