NOTICE OF APPEAL PURSUANT TO N.C. GEN. STAT § 7A-30(1) & N.C. R. APP. P. 14

TO THE HONORABLE SUPREME COURT OF NORTH CAROLINA:

Defendant North Carolina Rules Review Commission ("RRC"), hereby appeals to the Supreme Court of North Carolina from an order of the Court of Appeals dated March 2, 2016. The Court of Appeals' order is attached hereto as Attachment A. The order dismissed the RRC's appeal because the Notice of Appeal was not filed with the Supreme Court, and "pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. § 7A-27(a1), this Court is without jurisdiction to hear the appeal." The RRC's appeal presented the Court of Appeals with a substantial constitutional question of whether the RRC's construction of the North Carolina Constitution as subjecting the North Carolina State Board of Education ("SBOE") to the rulemaking provisions of the North Carolina Administrative Procedure Act ("APA") N.C. Gen. Stat. § 150B-1 *et seq.* was correct. The Court of Appeals should have reached and decided all issues necessary for determination of the appeal. In dismissing the RRC's appeal, the Court of Appeals misunderstood the scope of its appellate jurisdiction, and failed to decide the constitutional issue before it, thereby essentially deciding this constitutional question in favor of the SBOE.

In the event the Court finds the constitutional question to be substantial, the RRC intends to present the following issues in its brief for review:

1. Did the Superior Court err in granting summary judgment in favor of the SBOE and in failing to grant summary judgment in favor of Defendants-Appellants RRC and State of North Carolina? Respectfully submitted, this the 28th day of March, 2016.
